



Training on "E-Office : SPARROW " organized at ICAR-NRRI, Cuttack

An orientation training in virtual mode, in connection with implementation of SPARROW in respect of Administrative, Technical and Supporting cadre of ICAR has been conducted by ICAR-NRRI, Cuttack to the staff members of ICAR-National Rice Research Institute (NRRI), Cuttack and ICAR-Central Institute for Women in Agriculture (CIWA), Bhubaneswar, on 29th March 2022, at the instance of the ICT Division of the Council.

PERFORMANCE SMART APPRAISAL REPORT RECORDING ONLINE WINDOW (SPARROW) is an online system based on the comprehensive performance appraisal dossier that is maintained for each member of the Service by the State Government / Central Government. The aim of this system is to facilitate the electronic filling of PAR by officers in a way that is not only user friendly but also allows to fill anywhere anytime per convenience. Similar convenience is available to the officers at different levels in the workflow hierarchy of filling and submission process. The



system will also reduce delays in submission of completely filled APARs. ICAR has taken a decision to implement SPARROW from the Assessment Year 2021-22 for the staff members of Administrative, Technical and Supporting cadres.





At around 60 participants from both the institutes participated in this training program. The training was organized by the team of NRRI, Cuttack. Shri Munael Mohanty, Assistant & Custodian of ICAR-NRRI, Cuttack welcomed all the participants. Shri V.
