Further, she emphasized on role of ICAR-NRRI in terms of varietal development, evolving methods of soil-health maintenance, package of practices, agricultural



mechanization, quality control of rice, insect-pest control as well as outreach programmes towards betterment of farmer's community. The guests also released various publications of the Institute like 3 Books, 3 Research Bulletins, 16 Technology Bulletin and 9 Extension Bulletins.
