

<u>General advisory:</u> Farmers should harvest the matured crops and vegetables in dry days. Farmers may go for intercultural operations, fertilizer and pesticide application in the upcoming dry days. They should start sowing of summer vegetables by utilizing past rain water. They should provide mulching material or polythene cover to recently planted vegetables seedling to protect from increase in day temperature.

#### Pulses:

Harvest matured pulses in dry days. Rust infestation likely to occur in pulses, if observe spray Mancozeb 35.0%SC 3gram/ltr of water. If wilting will be observed after rainfall, then spray Carbendazim 2g/ltr of water to control.

#### **Summer Maize:**

There may be increase the infestation of **Red hairy caterpillar** in maize after rainfall, to minimize the infestation farmers may spray Neem oil 5ml/ltr of water or Chlorpyriphos 20 % EC @ 2ml/litre of water. Prolonged dry spell followed by rain may increase the infestation of **fall army worm in maize**. To control spray emamectin benzoate (5% S.G.) @ 0.4g per litre of water.

#### Vegetables.

Okra: To control Yellow Vain Mosaic Virus (YVMV) in Okra apply Neem oil (10000 ppm) @ 20 ml/ 10 liter at dawn or use yellow sticky trap to control this disease.

#### **Brinjal:**

There are chances of infestation of **Epilachna Beetle/Haddabeetle** in Brinjal and cucurbits crop; to manage Epilachna Beetle in cucurbits,spray neembased pesticide (Azadirachtin) 1500 PPM @ 3ml/litre of water at early stage of infestation; to manage Epilachna Beetle chemically, spray Chlorpyriphos 20 % EC @ 2ml/litre of water or Profenophos 50 % EC @ 2ml/litre of water.

FRUIT AND SHOOT BORER IN BRINJAL-Spray Neem based pesticide 1500ppm@600ml/acre at initial stages. Later on go for alternate spray of Spinosad 45%SC@70ml/acre and Thiodicarb@250g/acre at 15 days interval. If phomopsis blight will occur in brinjal, then spray zineb75%WP 2gram/litr of water.Cercopspera leaf spot may be found after rainfall, if observe, then spray Carbendazim orzineb75%WP 2gram/litr of water.If helicoverpa infestation will be found, sparay Flunendiamide or indoxacarb 2ml/litr of water.

#### **Cucutbits:**

To manage **Red Pumpkin Beetle** in Cucurbit crops spray Cyantraniliprole 10.26% OD @ 400-ml/acre or Imidacloprid 17.8% SL @ 60-ml/ acre or Chlorpyriphos 20% EC @ 400-ml/acre. **Late Blight** may happen due to rising day temperature. There are chances of infestation of **Downy Mildew** in cucurbit vegetables. To manage this disease in cucurbits spray Copper Hydroxide 77 % WP 12 @ 3-gram/litre or Carbendazim 12 % + Mancozeb 63 % WP @ 2-gram/litre.


Pointed gourd is at flowering and fruiting stage. Don't go for weeding .The grasses and weeds will help in maintaining the humidity and it is safe for creeping of the vines and does not allow the fruit to come in contact with soil and avoid fruit rot. High temperature leads to fungal wilting in pointed gourd, spray 1.5 ml Carbendazim in 1 litre water. Present weather may aggravate fruit and vine rot (symptoms: leaf spot, leaf blight, stem rot, fruit rot) of pointed gourd. If observe remove damaged fruit and vines from the field and should not be kept in and around the field. Spray alternately Copper Oxychloride 50% WP @ 3 g/litre of water and Metalaxyl 8% + Mancozeb 64% @ 2.5 g/litre of water in clear and dry weather.



#### Mango:

Water stress immediately after fruit set increases fruit dropping in Mango. Hence, protective irrigation is essential during the fruit development stage. Tocontrol fruit drop, spray Borax @2gm per lit. of water and apply Planofix @2ml per 5 lit. of water.For control of mango fruit borer spray Neem oil 3ml + chloripyriphos 1 ml perlitre of water along with stickers at marble stage of the fruit. The sprayingshould be preferably carried out during evening hours. To control bacterialcanker, three sprays of streptocycline (100 ppm) or Agrimycin-100 (100 ppm)after first visual symptom at 10- days intervals is recommended.

#### **Crop specific Agro-met Advisory**

General advisory: Farmers should harvest the matured crops and vegetables in dry days. Farmers may go for intercultural operations, fertilizer and pesticide application in the upcoming dry days. They should start sowing of summer vegetables by utilizing past rain water. They should provide mulching material or polythene cover to recently planted vegetables seedling to protect from increase in day temperature.

#### **Pulses:**

Harvest matured pulses in dry days. Rust infestation likely to occur in pulses, if observe spray Mancozeb 35.0%SC 3gram/ltr of water. If wilting will be observed after rainfall, then spray Carbendazim 2g/ltr of water to control.

#### **Summer Maize**

There may be increase the infestation of **Red hairy caterpillar** in maize after rainfall, to minimize the infestation farmers may spray Neem oil 5ml/ltr of water or Chlorpyriphos 20 % EC @ 2ml/litre of water. Prolonged dry spell followed by rain may increase the infestation of **fall army worm in maize**. To **control spray emamectin benzoate** (5% S.G.) @ 0.4g per litre of water.

### Vegetables:

Okra: To control Yellow Vain Mosaic Virus (YVMV) in Okra apply Neem oil (10000 ppm) @ 20 ml/ 10 liter at dawn or use yellow sticky trap to control this disease.

#### **Brinial:**

There are chances of infestation of **Epilachna Beetle/Haddabeetle** in Brinjal and cucurbits crop; to manage Epilachna Beetle in cucurbits, spray neembased pesticide (Azadirachtin) 1500 PPM @ 3ml/litre of water at early stage of infestation; to manage Epilachna Beetle chemically, spray Chlorpyriphos 20 % EC @ 2ml/litre of water or Profenophos 50 % EC @ 2ml/litre of water.

FRUIT AND SHOOT BORER IN BRINJAL-Spray Neem based pesticide 1500ppm@600ml/acre at initial stages. Later on go for alternate spray of Spinosad 45%SC@70ml/acre and Thiodicarb@250g/acre at 15 days interval. If phomopsis blight will occur in brinjal, then spray zineb75%WP 2gram/litr of water.Cercopspera leaf spot may be found after rainfall, if observe, then spray Carbendazim orzineb75%WP 2gram/litr of water.If helicoverpa infestation will be found, sparay Flunendiamide or indoxacarb 2ml/litr of water.

#### **Cucutbits:**

To manage **Red Pumpkin Beetle** in Cucurbit crops spray Cyantraniliprole 10.26% OD @ 400-ml/acre or Imidacloprid 17.8% SL @ 60-ml/ acre or Chlorpyriphos 20% EC @ 400-ml/acre. **Late Blight** may happen due to rising day temperature. There are chances of infestation of **Downy Mildew** in cucurbit vegetables. To manage this disease in cucurbits spray Copper Hydroxide 77 % WP 12 @ 3-gram/litre or Carbendazim 12 % + Mancozeb 63 % WP @ 2-gram/litre.

Pointed gourd is at flowering and fruiting stage. Don't go for weeding .The grasses and weeds will help in maintaining the humidity and it is safe for creeping of the vines and does not allow the fruit to come in contact with soil and avoid fruit rot. High temperature leads to fungal wilting in pointed gourd, spray 1.5 ml Carbendazim in 1 litre water. Present weather may aggravate fruit and vine rot (symptoms: leaf spot, leaf blight, stem rot, fruit rot) of pointed gourd. If observe remove damaged fruit and vines from the field and should not be kept in and around the field. Spray alternately Copper Oxychloride 50% WP @ 3 g/litre of water and Metalaxyl 8% + Mancozeb 64% @ 2.5 g/litre of water in clear and dry weather.


#### Fruit:

#### Mango:

Water stress immediately after fruit set increases fruit dropping in Mango. Hence, protective irrigation is essential during the fruit development stage. Tocontrol fruit drop, spray Borax @2gm per lit. of water and apply Planofix @2ml per 5 lit. of water. For control of mango fruit borer spray Neem oil 3ml + chloripyriphos 1 ml perlitre of water along with stickers at marble stage of the fruit. The sprayingshould be preferably carried out during evening hours. To control bacterialcanker, three sprays of streptocycline (100 ppm) or Agrimycin-100 (100 ppm)after first visual symptom at 10- days intervals is recommended.

## **Animal husbandry:**

Make necessary arrangement for clean and sufficient drinking water for the animals.

General advisory: Farmers should harvest the matured crops and vegetables in dry days. Farmers may go for intercultural operations, fertilizer and pesticide application in the upcoming dry days. They should start sowing of summer vegetables by utilizing past rain water. They should provide mulching material or polythene cover to recently planted vegetables seedling to protect from increase in day temperature.

#### **Pulses:**

Harvest matured pulses in dry days. Rust infestation likely to occur in pulses, if observe spray Mancozeb 35.0%SC 3gram/ltr of water. If wilting will be observed after rainfall, then spray Carbendazim 2g/ltr of water to control.

#### **Summer Maize:**

There may be increase the infestation of **Red hairy caterpillar** in maize after rainfall, to minimize the infestation farmers may spray Neem oil 5ml/ltr of water or Chlorpyriphos 20 % EC @ 2ml/litre of water. Prolonged dry spell followed by rain may increase the infestation of **fall army worm in maize**. To control spray emamectin benzoate (5% S.G.) @ 0.4g per litre of water.

#### **Vegetables**

Okra: To control Yellow Vain Mosaic Virus (YVMV) in Okra apply Neem oil (10000 ppm) @ 20 ml/ 10 liter at dawn or use yellow sticky trap to control this disease.

#### **Brinjal:**

There are chances of infestation of **Epilachna Beetle/Haddabeetle** in Brinjal and cucurbits crop; to manage Epilachna Beetle in cucurbits,spray neembased pesticide (Azadirachtin) 1500 PPM @ 3ml/litre of water at early stage of infestation; to manage Epilachna Beetle chemically, spray Chlorpyriphos 20 % EC @ 2ml/litre of water or Profenophos 50 % EC @ 2ml/litre of water.

FRUIT AND SHOOT BORER IN BRINJAL-Spray Neem based pesticide 1500ppm@600ml/acre at initial stages. Later on go for alternate spray of Spinosad 45%SC@70ml/acre and Thiodicarb@250g/acre at 15 days interval. If phomopsis blight will occur in brinjal, then spray zineb75%WP 2gram/litr of water.Cercopspera leaf spot may be found after rainfall, if observe, then spray Carbendazim orzineb75%WP 2gram/litr of water.If helicoverpa infestation will be found, sparay Flunendiamide or indoxacarb 2ml/litr of water.

#### **Cucutbits:**

To manage **Red Pumpkin Beetle** in Cucurbit crops spray Cyantraniliprole 10.26% OD @ 400-ml/acre or Imidacloprid 17.8% SL @ 60-ml/ acre or Chlorpyriphos 20% EC @ 400-ml/acre. **Late Blight** may happen due to rising day temperature. There are chances of infestation of **Downy Mildew** in cucurbit vegetables. To manage this disease in cucurbits spray Copper Hydroxide 77 % WP 12 @ 3-gram/litre or Carbendazim 12 % + Mancozeb 63 % WP @ 2-gram/litre.





#### Mango:

For control of mango fruit borer spray Neem oil 3ml + chloripyriphos 1 ml perlitre of water along with stickers at marble stage of the fruit. The sprayingshould be preferably carried out during evening hours. To control bacterialcanker, three sprays of streptocycline (100 ppm) or Agrimycin-100 (100 ppm)after first visual symptom at 10- days intervals is recommended.


