

Cucutbits: Late Blight may happen due to rising day temperature. There are chances of infestation of Downy Mildew in cucurbit vegetables. To manage this disease in cucurbits spray Copper Hydroxide 77 % WP 12 @ 3-gram/litre or Carbendazim 12 % + Mancozeb 63 % WP @ 2-gram/litre.

Pointed gourd is at flowering and fruiting stage. Present weather may aggravate fruit and vine rot (symptoms: leaf spot, leaf blight, stem rot, fruit rot) of pointed gourd. If observe remove damaged fruit and vines from the field and should not be kept in and around the field. 
